INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

Pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of the European Regulation on the protection of personal data 2016/679

COMPETITION “AGILE PILOTING - UNITE PROJECT” TO RESPOND TO THE NEEDS EXPRESSED BY THE “AZIENDA SANITARIA SOCIO SANITARIA TERRITORIALE (ASST) NORD MILANO”

The purpose of this document is to inform you about the lawfulness and purposes of the processing of the personal data you have provided and that the processing operations will be carried out in full compliance with the principles of fairness and transparency, as well as the protection of your privacy and your rights.

Therefore, in accordance with the provisions of European Regulation 2016/679 (hereinafter the "Regulation") and Legislative Decree no. 196 of 30 June 2003, as amended by Legislative Decree no. 101 of 10 August 2018 (hereinafter the "Privacy Code"), we provide you with the following precise and clear information on the processing of personal data, in accordance with the provisions of Article 13 of the Regulation.

1. The Data Controller.

The Data Controller is the public body Regione Lombardia, with headquarters in Piazza Città di Lombardia, 1 - 20124 Milan.

2. Purpose and legal basis of the processing.

We inform you that during processing operations, the following categories of personal data will be collected, for the purposes and according to the legal bases indicated below:

3. Fully automated decision-making, including profiling.

Your personal data will not be subject to any fully automated decision-making process, including profiling.

4. Obligation to provide personal data. Consequences of refusal.

Providing your personal data is necessary, and therefore any refusal to provide it, in whole or in part, may make it impossible for the Data Controller to properly perform all obligations, including the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or the exercise of official authority vested in it.

5. Communication and dissemination of personal data to third parties.

The recipients of your personal data have been adequately trained to process your personal data and ensure the same level of security offered by the Data Controller.

Your personal data will not be disclosed.

Furthermore, your personal data will be communicated to third parties, namely representatives of ASST Nord Milano involved in the evaluation of the competition for Agile Piloting programs conducted in the regional territory and to representatives of the other partner regions of the Project for Agile Piloting programs conducted within Living Labs or Testbeds located in the other Partner Regions, as Data Processors pursuant to Article 28 of EU Regulation 2016/679, who provide the Data Controller with services instrumental to the purposes indicated in this privacy policy.

The list of said third parties is available at the Data Controller's headquarters.

6. Transfers of personal data outside the European Economic Area.

Your personal data will not be transferred outside the European Economic Area.

7. Retention times.

Your data provided for participation in the competition will be retained in full for the duration of the Competition and for ten years from the provision of the fee for the agile piloting program .

8. The rights of interested parties.

You may exercise, at any time, where applicable, the rights set forth in Articles 15 to 22 of EU Regulation 679/2016 by submitting a request to the Data Controller.

However, we would like to point out that, pursuant to certain legislative measures introduced by national law, the Data Controller may, in certain circumstances, limit the scope of its obligations and rights, as specified in Article 23 of the Regulation and Article 2-undecies of the Privacy Code.

The following rights are recognized:

- **Right of access (art. 15)**
- **Right to rectification (art. 16)**
- **Right to restriction of processing (art. 18)**
- **Right to object (Articles 21 and 22)**

9. Complaint to the Supervisory Authority.

If you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of applicable law, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the Italian Data Protection Authority (www.garanteprivacy.it), pursuant to Article 77 of the Regulation, or to take appropriate legal action pursuant to Article 79 of the Regulation.

10. The Data Protection Officer.

11. Changes.

The Data Controller reserves the right to update this policy, including in light of future changes to personal data protection legislation.
